I hereby acknowledge that I or my student wishes to attend classes at Académie Extrava Danse Academy (EDA) 1595 Laurier Street, Rockland, Ontario, Canada, K4K 1C8 or at 361 Main Street East, Hawkesbury, Ontario, Canada, K6A 1A8.

I acknowledge that EDA has provided information on their sanitization and safety procedures including social distancing measures. EDA has also taken steps to ensure that any persons that works on the premises are aware of and will comply with the new protocols. Students and staff will be asked to confirm their health status and will have their temperature checked each time they enter the studio.

I acknowledge and accept that there is a risk that I or my student could be exposed to COVID-19, or any other illness while attending EDA.

In consideration of EDA agreeing to accept me or my student in classes, I agree to release EDA I, their officers, directors, employees, agents and volunteers (the "Releasees") from any and all causes of action, claims, demands, requests, damages or any recourse whatsoever in respect of any personal injuries or other damages which may occur or arise as a result of exposure to COVID-19 during a visit to EDA

I do hereby acknowledge and agree that notwithstanding the generality of the foregoing, I declare that I will not commence litigation or otherwise seek to recover damages or other compensation against the Releasees based on any action, claim, demand, request, loss or any recourse whatsoever arising from any potential or actual exposure to COVID-19 while attending EDA and further acknowledge that the Releasees can rely on this Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk as a complete defence to any and all claims, damages, causes of action, or recourse or liability that may arise at any time.

I have carefully reviewed this Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk and acknowledge that I fully understand the terms as set out above. I acknowledge that I am signing this Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk voluntarily.

Regulations set forth by the government of Ontario state that any business that is open and provide in person teaching or instruction must enable students to maintain physical distance of at least 2 meters from any other person who is not in the same household as them **except where necessary for teaching and instruction that cannot be effectively provided if physical distancing is maintained.**

I hereby acknowledge that teaching staff might come into safe physical contact with students in order to correct or reinforce proper and safe technical training during the dance class.

***All teaching staff will sanitize their hands and wear masks when coming into closer contact with students, if required**

- **Spotting acrobatic tricks which require the teachers' aid in order to assure safety and proper guidance of the students' technical development.**
- **Aiding students in the proper alignment of the body or limbs in any and all dance classes.**
- **Assisting younger dancers in needs of physical contact in order for them to feel comfortable and understand the nature of the movement or dance class activity.**

Conditions of Enrolment

- Teachers and schedules are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- No refunds for classes cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control (eg. legislated closure/increment weather etc.)
- Should Public Health directions require the studio to be closed due to an outbreak situation, classes will continue using a ZOOM virtual format, following the evening and weekend schedules as much as possible.
- All class time not delivered either in person or via an online platform will be credited to the students account as credit usable towards any class.
- Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk Waiver must be signed and dated in order to be eligible to take part in classes.
- Académie Extrava Danse Academy is not responsible for students before and after class.
- Académie Extrava Danse Academy is not responsible for lost items.
- I consent to the use of archival photographs and/or video footage of my child as part of the image bank and marketing.

Académie Extrava Danse Academy – Procedure for Entering and Exiting the Building/General Information

Before entering the studio at the beginning of September 2022, every student must submit this signed waiver provided by Académie Extrava Danse Academy.

Prior to arriving at EDA, we ask that all students fully prepare to dance. This entails having hair done, dance attire on underneath their street clothes, feet prepared for pointe work (if applicable), and dance shoes easily accessible in one bag to limit extra clothing items being brought into the dance space. This will make for an efficient transition of people entering and exiting the space.

Only registered students may enter the building to reduce cross-over contamination and to maintain appropriate physical distancing requirements before and after scheduled class times.

- Students must be masked to enter Académie Extrava Danse Academy, if required by legislation.
- Students will be allowed entry just prior to their class times and will be asked to leave quickly after their class is over.
- All individuals will be screened at the entrance, if required by legislation.

Entry will be denied to any person who has any of the symptoms outlined below, and they will be directed home and instructed to contact their health care provider.

Once inside, students will be asked to disinfect their hands. All outdoor belongings (shoes, jackets, dance bags, et cetera) should be placed in dance bags and will be taken by the student to the studio and stored in a designated spot. For rainy / snowy days, please have a plastic bag available to place wet belongings in.

Waiting areas are closed and students who are about to enter their class will stand at the space markers placed in the common areas to ensure two metre physical distancing requirements are adhered to at all times.

Once students are able to enter the studio, they will go directly to their place at the barre, or their square in the centre of the room. While in the studio, students must stay in their designated area unless otherwise instructed by the teacher. If a student needs to use the washroom or leave the studio for any reason, they must ask the teacher and follow their instructions. Hand disinfectant must be used before entering the classroom.

Dancers must have their own equipment. Sharing of personal items including food and water bottles is strictly prohibited. Water fountains, lockers, and dressing rooms will not be in use, if directed by legislation.

Parents/guardians are advised to wait with students until the designated drop off time outside of the building, and to meet their student outside the building after class at the designated time.

Children's safe exiting of the building to a parent/guardian will be monitored by staff of the building. Classrooms are sanitized and reset between classes so strict adherence to the schedules is a must.
